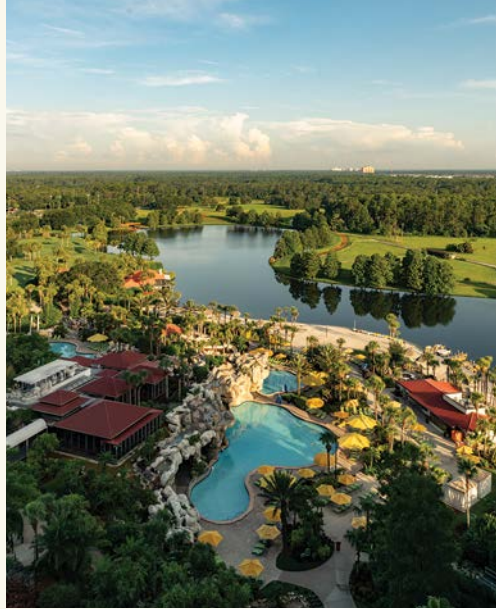
Annual Meeting: Focus on Skin Cancer

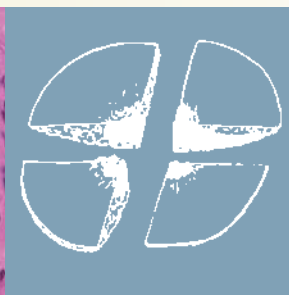
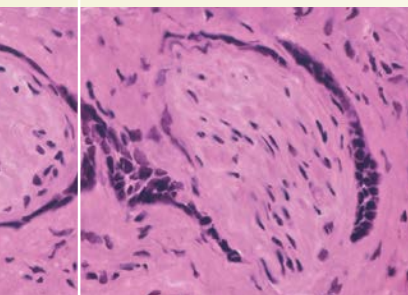

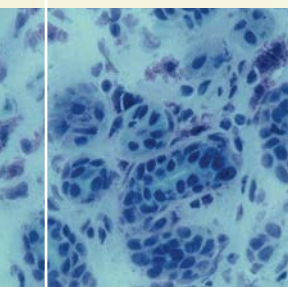
